In accordance with 23 CFR § 450.334, Old Colony Planning Council (OCPC) is making the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2019 Annual Listing of Obligated Projects available for public review. The Annual Listing of Projects provides the projects for which federal funds have been obligated in FFY 2019 (October 1, 2018 - September 30, 2019).

Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs) are required, under the authorized transportation bill, Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act, to publish an annual listing of projects which funds have been obligated in the preceding year as a record of project delivery and progress report for public information and disclosure. In addressing FAST Act requirements, this report lists all transportation projects in the region that were obligated during FFY 2019.

The obligated list of projects must be developed through a cooperative effort with the metropolitan planning organization (MPO), state and public transportation operators responsible for tracking project authorizations and obligations spent during the immediately preceding fiscal year.

Obligation is defined as the Federal government's legal commitment to pay the Federal share of a project's cost. An obligated project is one that has been authorized by the federal agency and funds have been obligated. Projects for which funds have been obligated are not necessarily initiated or completed in the program year, and the amount of the obligation will not necessarily equal the total cost of the project.
