



NOTICE OF PUBLIC REVIEW AND COMMENT PERIOD

▪ FFY 2020-2024 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) AMENDMENT 2

In accordance with the Public Participation Process developed by the Old Colony Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), Old Colony Planning Council (OCPC) is making the FFY 2020-2024 TIP Amendment 1 available for public review and comment. Copies of this document are available for review at the OCPC Offices (8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.), on the OCPC Website <http://www.ocpcrpa.org/>, and/or upon request. This notice will initiate a 21-Day Public Review and Comment Period. This process will also be used as Brockton Area Transit Authority's (BAT) public participation process. BAT, the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5307(c) applicant, has consulted with the Old Colony MPO and concurs that the public involvement process adopted by the Old Colony MPO for development of the TIP satisfies the public hearing requirements that pertain to the development of the Program of Projects for the regular Section 5307, Urbanized Area Formula Program, grant applications including the provisions for public notice and the time established for public review and comment. Public notice of public involvement activities and time established for public review and comments on the TIP will satisfy the program of projects (POP) requirements. The public discussion of the TIP at Old Colony JTC, Old Colony MPO, and transportation meetings satisfies the Program of Projects (POP) public hearing requirements of the FTA. A public meeting of the OCPC and Old Colony MPO advisory committee, the Old Colony Joint Transportation Committee (JTC), is scheduled for March 5, 2020 at 12 PM. Furthermore, a public meeting of the Old Colony MPO is scheduled for March 17, 2020 at 10 AM to hear public comments and consider endorsement. OLD COLONY TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) AMENDMENT 2

The Old Colony Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is a program of capital improvements and operating assistance for the transportation system in the Old Colony Region. The Old Colony TIP lists projects (highway, bridge, and transit) and operational assistance that receive federal funds, and may list some projects that do not receive federal funds.

AMENDMENT 2

The FFY 2020-2024 Old Colony TIP Amendment 2 is comprised of the following changes.
