

Solution 3: The development of more local food processing through the encouragement of private action or the State Food Authority.


Solution 4: The development of home and community gardens.


## MA Agriculture Key Statistics





### Agricultural Land Uses in MA










#### Residents of Color: Growing % in Cities



#### Age Cohorts by Race: Growing Diversity




### Food Insecurity in Massachusetts




700,000 people –
